All of the world's top 10 BioPharmaceutical companies and 14 of the world's top 15 medical technology companies have operations in Ireland.

Ireland is Europe's second largest exporter of medical devices, supplying products such as contact lenses, stents, diagnostic reagents and artificial joints. The sector continues to evolve, expanding its capabilities to include digital health/connected health, industry 5.0 / smart factory and next-generation technologies.
